Jason has a passion for serving transitional-aged-youth and is committed to assisting individuals explore and define their goals and helping them to begin the journey towards self-sufficiency.

Carol Roberts has served as the President and CEO of LSS of Northern California since 2012. During her tenure, the organization has grown from a modest homeless services organization with programs in San Francisco, Sacramento, Concord and Stockton to serving nearly 4,000 individuals annually across eight Northern California counties. Current LSS programming includes supportive housing for families, seniors, adults with disabilities and other adults; transitional housing and extensive services for transition-age former foster youth and adults with HIV/AIDS; prevention and intervention services for vulnerable foster youth; vocational programming for youth (featuring two separate social enterprises); and financial management services for seniors and other vulnerable individuals.
